**Project Name:** Croatian Way Seawall Repair

**Application Type / Description:** The proposal is to reinforce and repair the existing rock seawall with a light reinforced concrete face butted right up against it as closely as the contractor is able and buried deeper to make further undercutting extremely unlikely. The concrete toe of the existing wall will be removed and the new facing will go in its place so there will be no new footprint on the beach.

**Decision:** Approved, with conditions

**SEPA Threshold Determination:** The City of Anacortes issued a Mitigated Determination of Nonsignificance (MDNS) on July 22, 2021 using the optional DNS process of WAC 197-11-355. There were no appeals.
